


The Treatment Conference

In the 1980's the average person probably didn't get braces. Today, everyone seems to have them. Although the cost of everything from cars to milk have gone up significantly, braces haven't gone up nearly as much. Not only are they a good buy, we also have payment plans to fit your budget.



Start With A No Fee EXAM

I like to examine all children at age 7. That way I can tell parents and their general dentist whether or not braces will be necessary. Ask any of our secretaries to make you an appointment on any Friday or selected Saturdays.

During our time together I will provide you an orthodontic exam at no fee. This allows you to get your questions answered so you can decide if braces are right for you - and not have to worry about the expense.

Braces for Adults

For adults it's not too late to correct crooked teeth, overbites, underbites, or jaw joint problems. Adult treatment takes a little longer than children, but the results are usually about the same.

The Records Visit

If you believe braces are right for you, then the next step is a thorough examination. This exam includes:

1. Models of your teeth
2. Photographs of your face and teeth
3. 2 full face x-rays to be able to see the jaw / tooth relationships to plot expected growth and development.
4. A thorough written report of your exam for you.



Questions



Q. *Do braces hurt?*

A. There have been some fantastic advances in orthodontics to make treatment more comfortable. Smaller, smoother brackets and gentler wires provide a much less uncomfortable continuous small force over a long period rather than a strong force for only a short period of time. Often there is some soreness for two to three days after each adjustment but over the counter pain relievers usually are all that are needed.

Q. *Will braces affect playing sports?*

A. You should be able to play just about any sport or activity. We highly recommend wearing a mouth guard in contact sports where you might be hit in the face.

Q. *What kind of braces are available?*

A. In the past, there was only one type of braces available, and it wasn't designed for looks. Modern technology gives you choices for braces, including traditional stainless steel braces, clear nearly invisible ceramic braces, gold braces, and Invisalign (no wires) removable clear braces.
